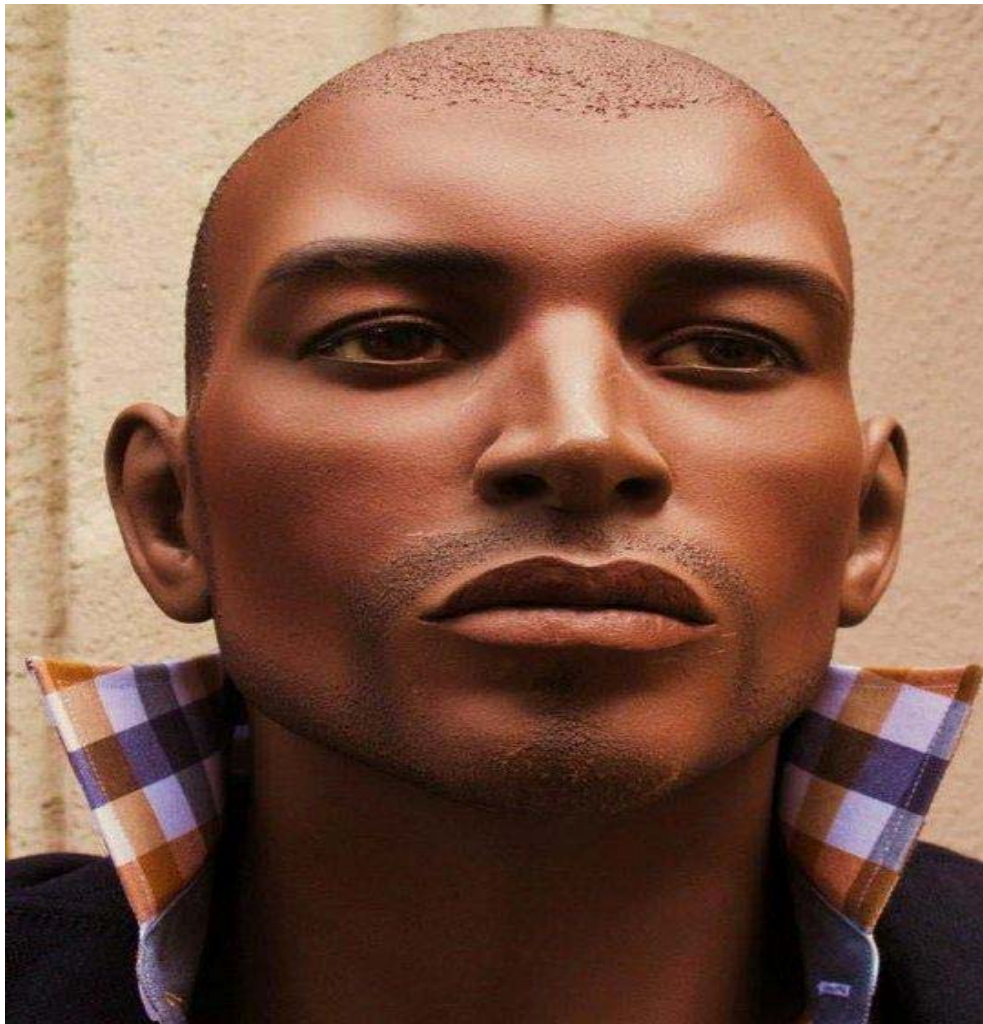


- Eine „schwarze Ausstellungspuppe“, die die Gemüter in einem Geschäft erregt:



Sometimes racists really still can surprise me. This mannequin at the picture was standing for years in front of a clothes shop in Graz, Hofgasse, what is right in the center of the city (so just a few citizens, who are foreigners or people with migration background and almost opposite of it you can see the Stocker Verlag). But there have been some people, who hated the mannequin at the picture. When they passed there, some of them called him "Bimbo" or "Nigger". One customer told the shop owner: "You know, my husband really would like to come to your shop, but as long as this black guy is standing here, he will not come." Some weeks ago, two young women passed and just "by chance", they touched the mannequin with their bags. He was falling down and destroyed to a lot of small pieces. The two women just were giggling and went away. The shop owner was looking for weeks now for a new mannequin with darker skin colour. but, he said, they are really hard to find. So meanwhile, a mannequin with white color is standing there³.
